The MCEU Hospitality project is an initiative that aims at equipping hospitality employees with the necessary skills to adapt to the changing landscape brought about by the COVID-19 pandemic and the EU's push for sustainability and digitalization in the industry.

This initiative develops specialised micro-credential courses for green and digital skills in hospitality sector, meeting society's evolving demands. The project aims to create an online platform for issuing, storing, and verifying micro-credentials, using EU resources like Europass and the European Digital Credentials for Learning, for skill recognition and transferability. Targeting 500 learners across 5 courses in Spain, Iceland, and Denmark, the project aligns with EU recommendations and the EU Skills Agenda on vocational education and training.
